 - 1. Make sure to highlight the strengths and weaknesses that justify your decision about the proposal
 - b. Secondary advocate
 - i. Agree or disagree with primary advocate
 - ii. Add additional insight
 - iii. Clarify points of confusion
 - c. Whole Funding Panel Group
 - i. Rank all proposal for your group after a panel conversation
 - 1. Divide proposals into FOUR categories:
 - 1. Nonfundable (not good)
 - 2. Fundable with after major revisions (OK)
 - 3. Fundable after minor revisions (Good)
 - 4. Fundable (Excellent)
 - ii. Rank and submit your top THREE proposals to your group faculty leader
 - iii. Faculty will choose the top TWO from each group
